A. Because God's justice and truth require it: only the death of the God's Son could pay for our sin.

Q 41. WHY WAS HE "BURIED?"

A. His burial testifies that He really died.

Q 42. SINCE CHRIST DIED FOR US, WHY MUST WE ALSO DIE?

A. Our death does not pay the debt for our sin. Rather, it puts an end to our sinning and is our entrance into eternal life.

A. To assure me during attacks of deepest dread and temptation that Christ my Lord,

by suffering unspeakable anguish, pain, and terror of soul, especially on the cross but also earlier, has delivered me from the anguish and torment of hell.
