Q21. WHAT IS TRUE FAITH?

A. True faith is

not only a sure knowledge

whereby I hold as true all that God has revealed to us in His Word;

but also a hearty trust,

which the Holy Spirit works in me by the Gospel,

that not only to others, but too me also,

forgiveness of sins,

eternal righteousness,

and salvation

are freely given by God, merely of grace, only for the sake of Christ's merits.

a creed beyond doubt,

Q19. WHAT ARE THESE ARTICLES?

A. I believe in God, the Father, almighty,
maker of heaven and earth.
And in Jesus Christ,
his only begotten Son, our Lord;
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,
and born of the virgin Mary;
suffered under Pontius Pilate;
was crucified, dead, and was buried;
he descended into hell;
the third day he rose again from the dead;

he ascended into heaven, and sits at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he shall come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit;
I believe a holy catholic church, the communion of saints; the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body; and the life everlasting.

WEDNESDAY: Why do you have a hearty trust in the Gospel of Christ?

If you don't how might you become more trusting?

THURSDAY: God gives His grace (unmerited favor) to us freely. Why?

FRIDAY: Do some research on the Apostles Creed. When was it written, by whom, when was it accepted by the church as a summary of Christian belief?

SATURDAY: read the corresponding essay in *THE GOOD NEWS WE ALMOST FORGOT* Write down any thoughts and/or questions that come to mind after reading the essay.
